

Brooksward School KS2 Results 2017-18

Brooksward School results comparison July 2017 – July 2018:

We are very happy with the results we achieved in all subjects, particularly Reading where, following our focus, we made a significant improvement in both age-related and Greater Depth.

Compared to all schools nationally, pupils at Brooksward School achieved age-related results significantly above the national average in Writing and Maths and Reading. Pupils at Brooksward achieving Greater Depth are broadly in line with the national average in Maths and Writing, and slightly above in Reading.

Pupils achieving the age-related expectations in reading, writing and maths combined was **97%** which was up from **75%** in 2016 and above the 2018 national of **64%**.

Brooksward School Progress from KS1-2 July 2018:

Progress for Year 6 pupils is calculated by comparing scaled scores from their end of Year 2 data (taken in 2014) with the scaled scores from their Year 6 test and teacher assessment data (2018). Expected progress would be 0.0, not enough progress would be a value less than 0.0 and children making more than expected progress would be a positive value.

Average progress in all subjects is well above expected (0.0) with 6.6 in Reading, 5.7 in writing and 5.6 in maths. This shows that children at Brooksward School made more progress between KS1 and 2 than the national average.
