Brooksward School Foundation Results 2023

Children in the Foundation stage work towards a Good Level of Development (GLD) which is a measure of average attainment prior to Year 1. In 2022 **75%** of pupils at Brooksward achieved this level compared to **65%** nationally in 2022. In 2023, Brooksward had **78%** of children achieving GLD compared to ??? nationally in 2022. NOTE: **The 2023 national has not yet been released but we remain above the 2022 national.** This shows that achievement in the foundation stage at Brooksward is higher than in all schools nationally

Brooksward School Phonics Screening 2023

Children in Year 1 are required to take a Phonics Screening Check to ensure they are on track to becoming confident readers. In 2022 **69%** of Year 1 pupils passed the check compared to **75%** nationally in 2022, which unfortunately shows the impact of consistent phonics teaching in early school years and the impact of the school closures. In 2023, **88%** of pupils passed the phonics screening compared to **81%** nationally in 2023, which shows the effectiveness of phonics teaching throughout the school and means that pupils at Brooksward are better prepared to become lifelong readers by the time they leave Year 1 than all pupils nationally.
